

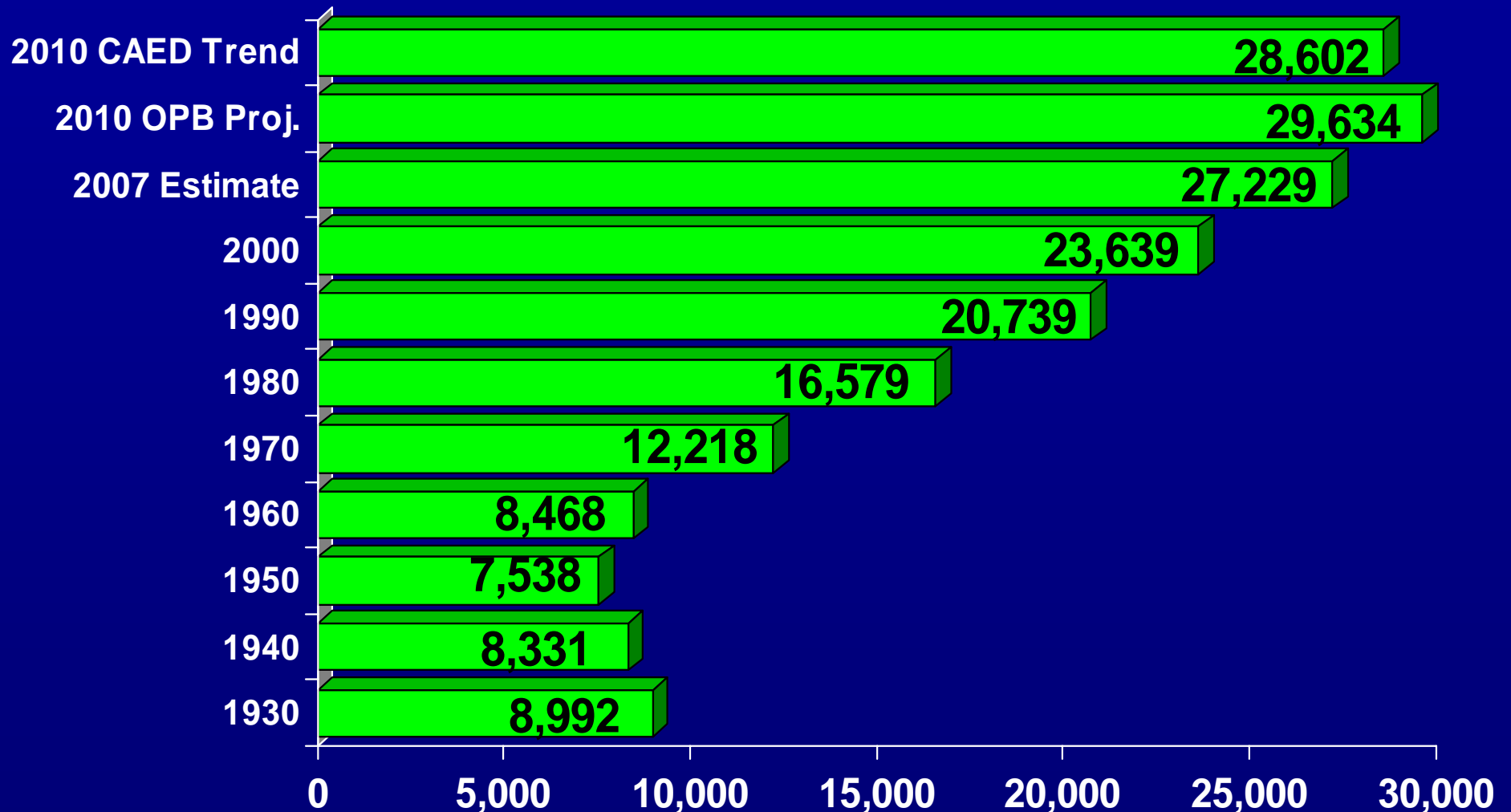

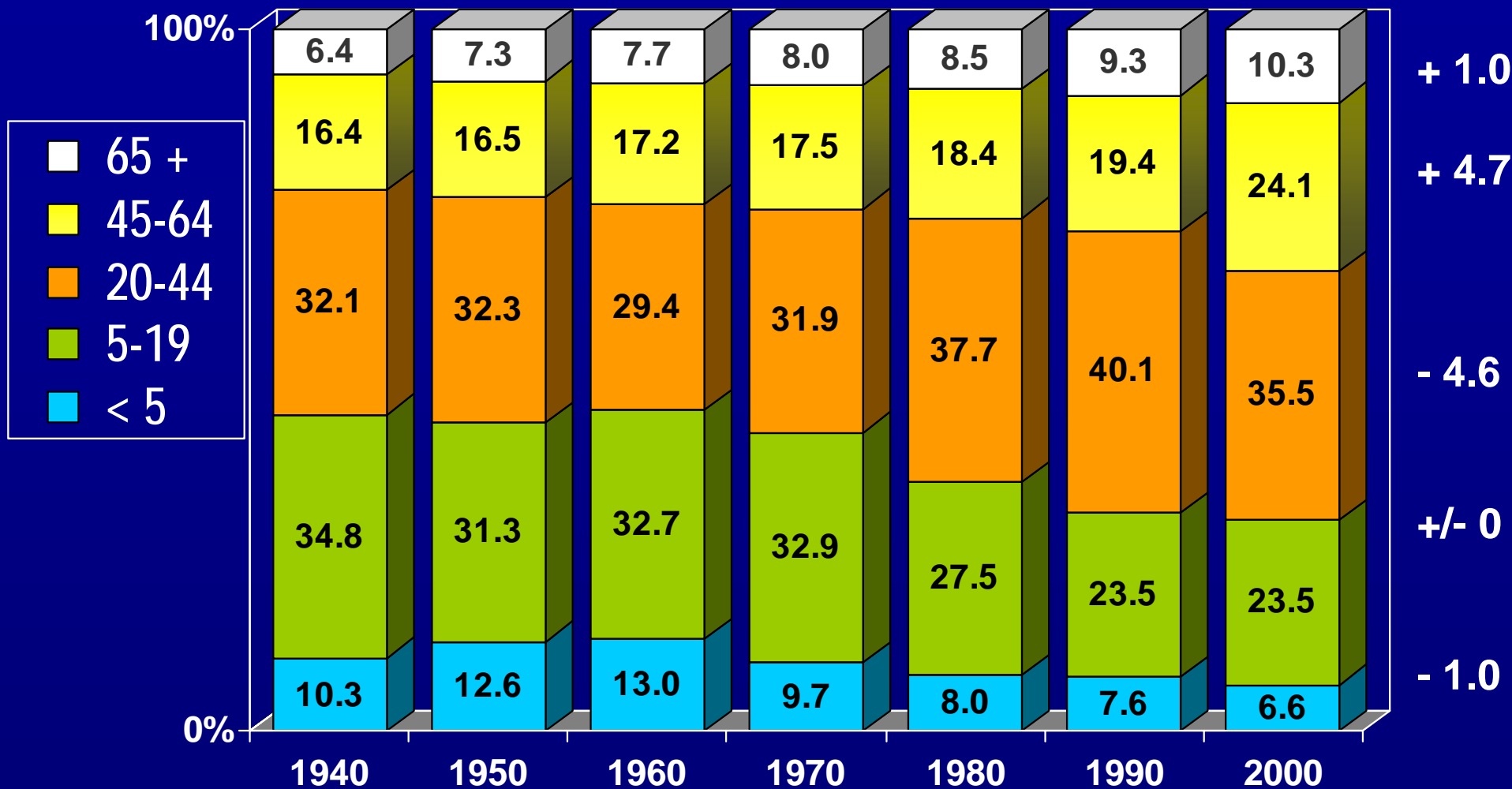
Total Population Jones County

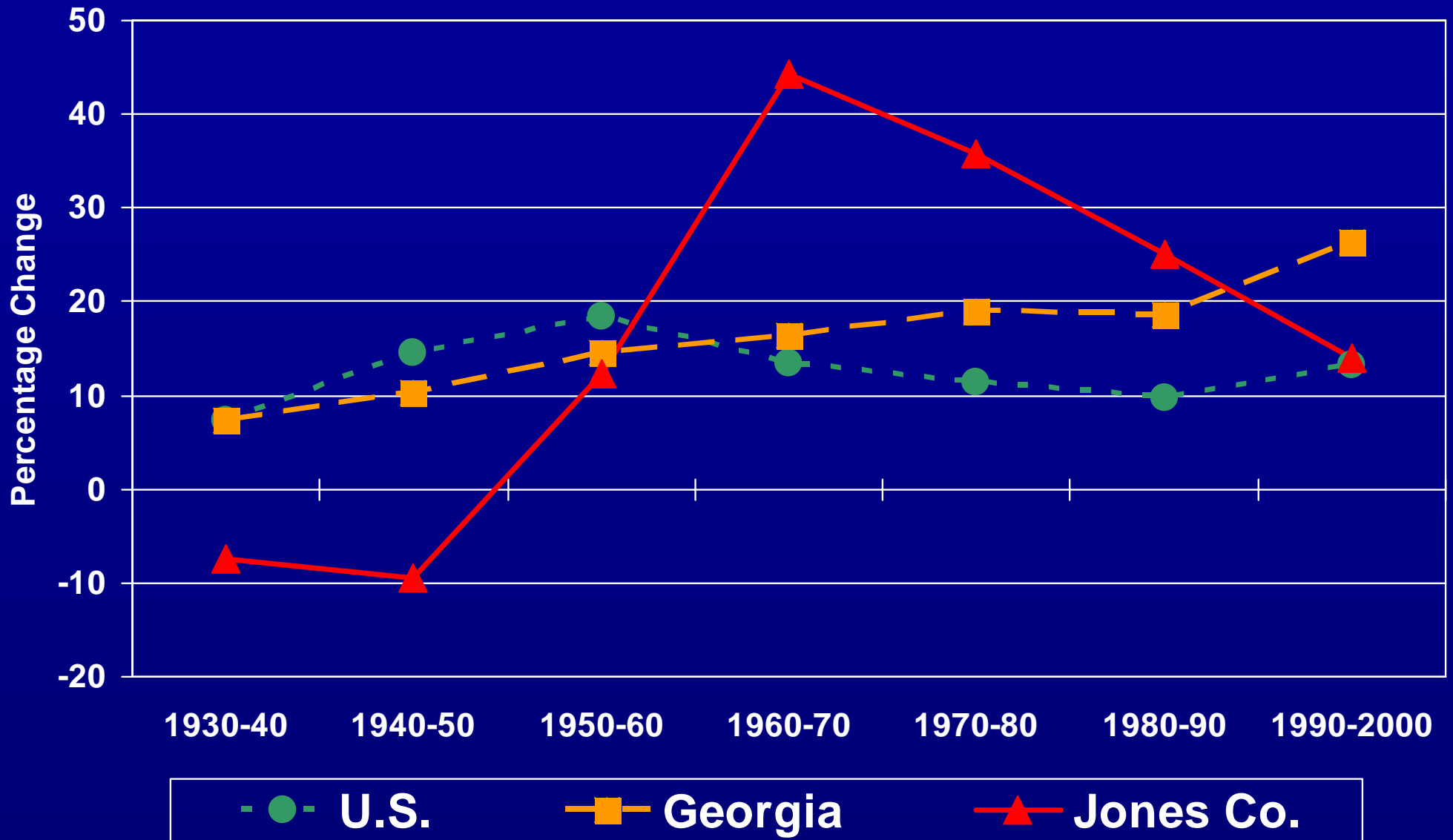

Population Change: 1930-2000



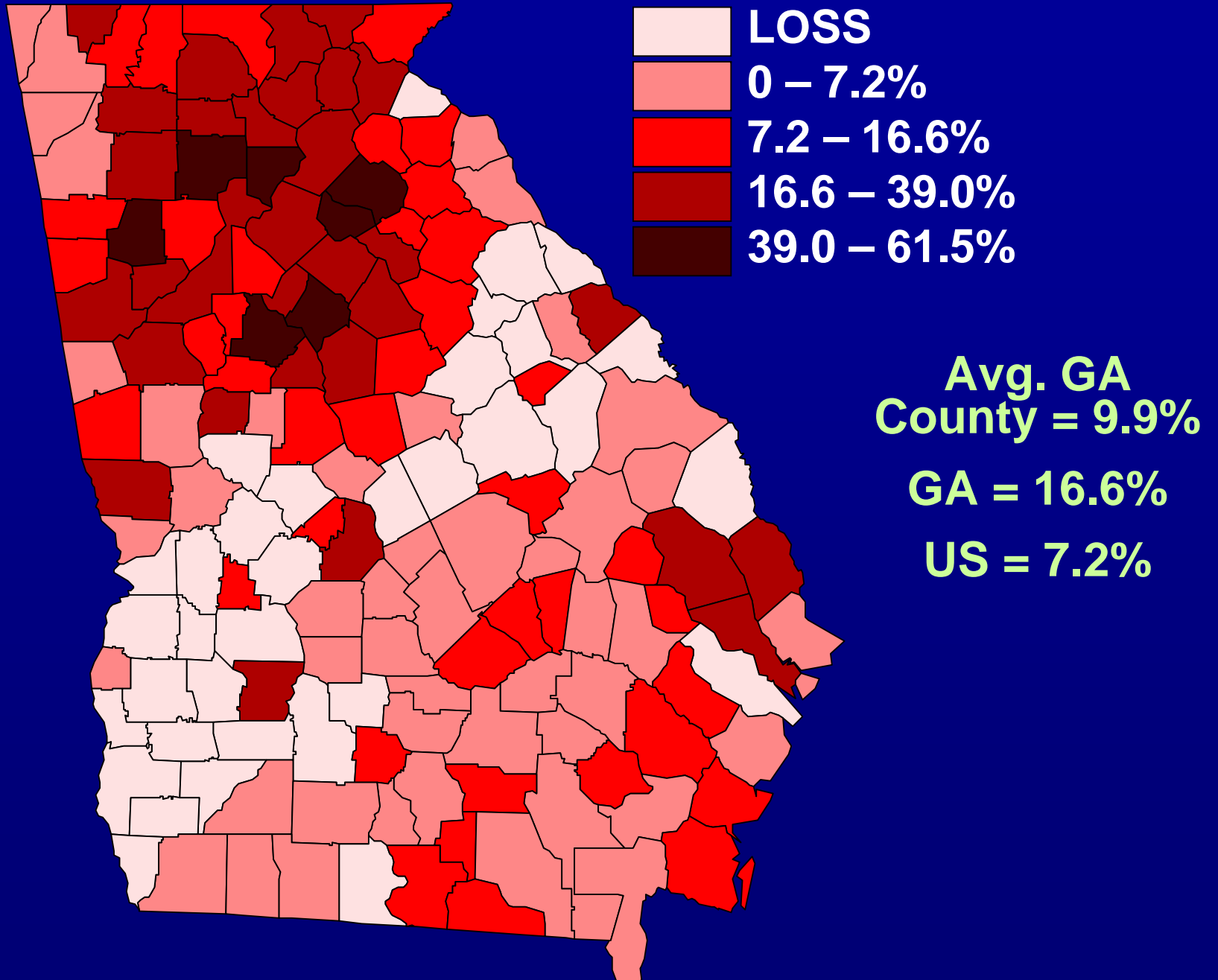

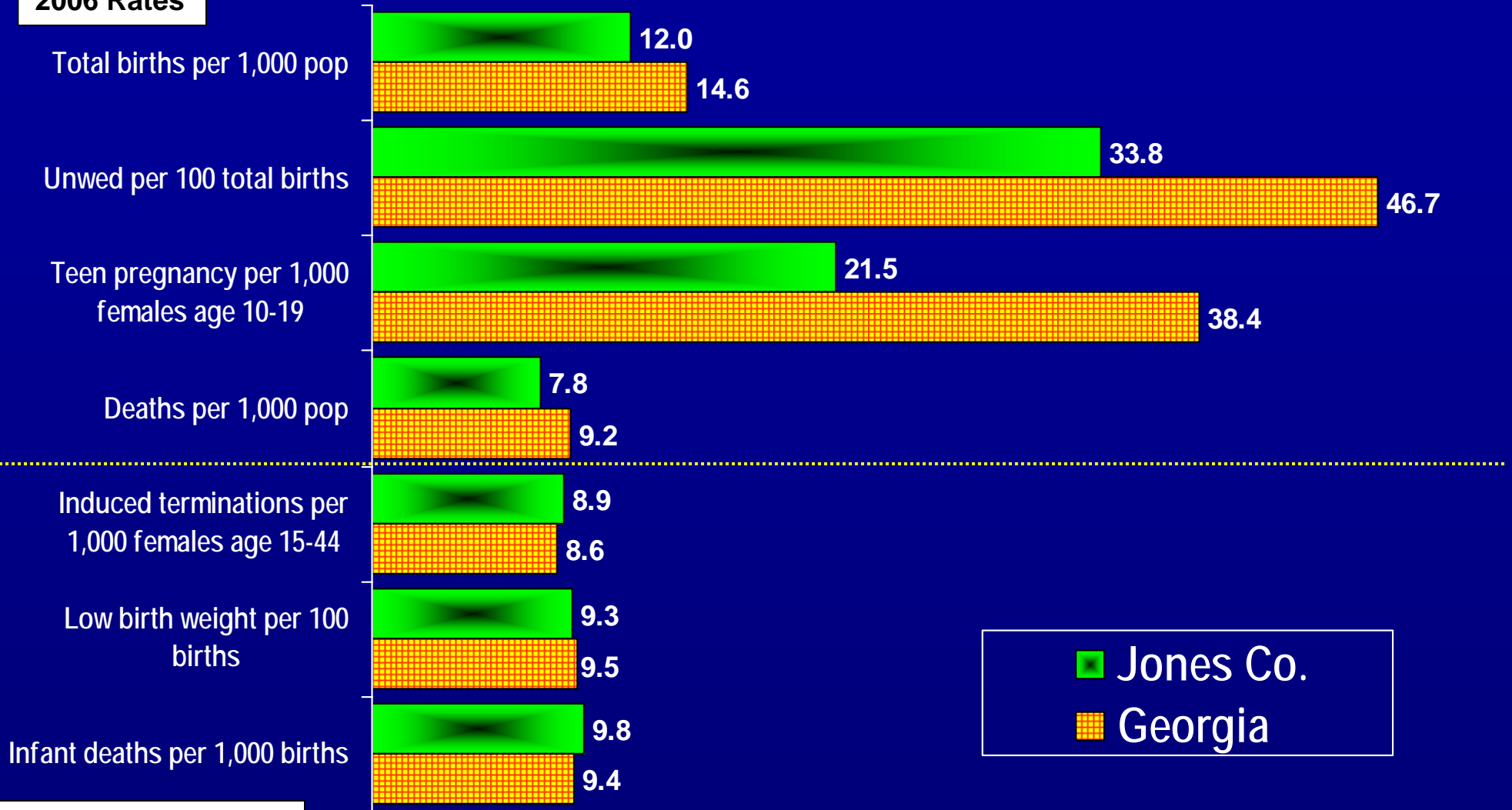

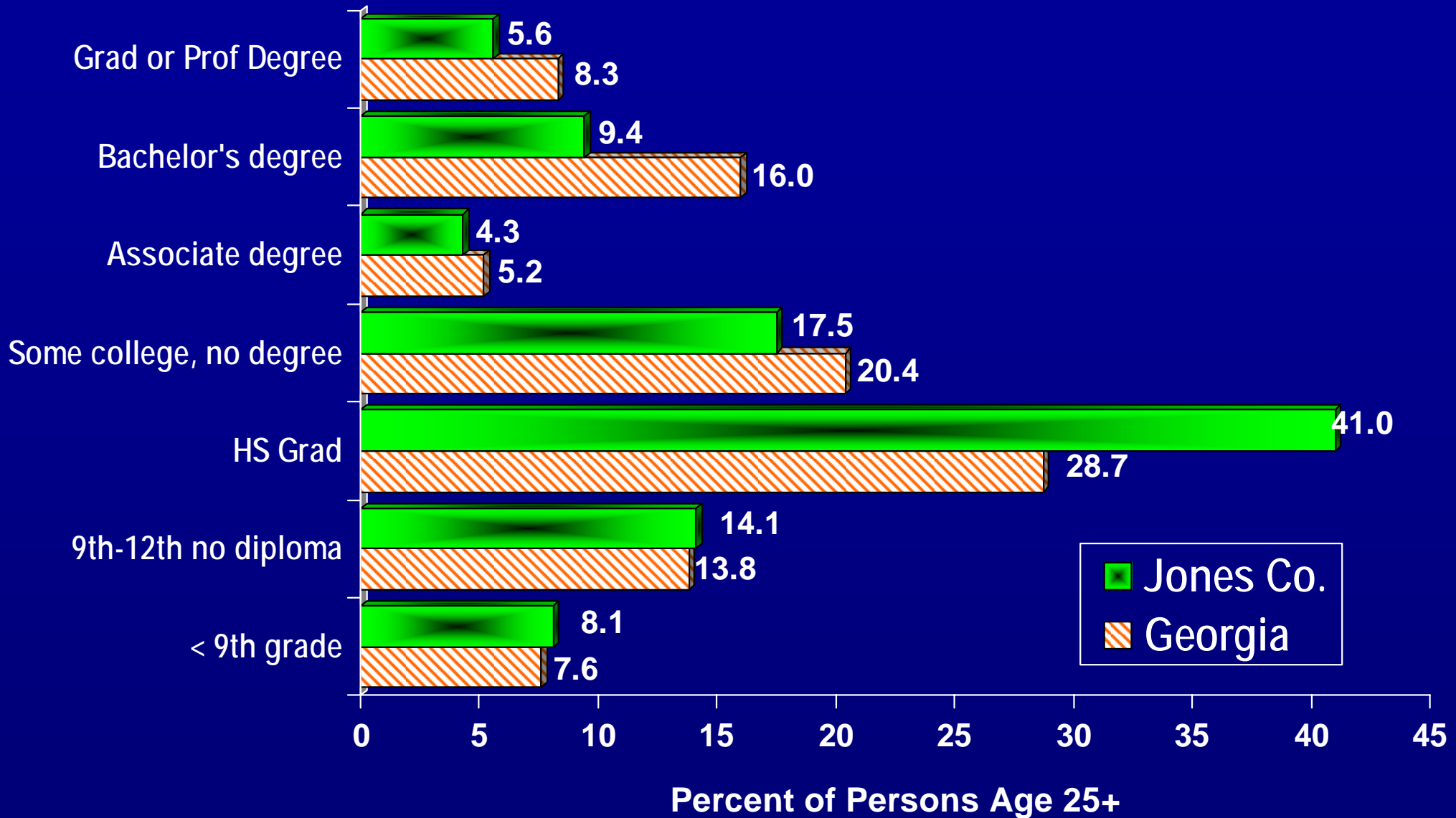

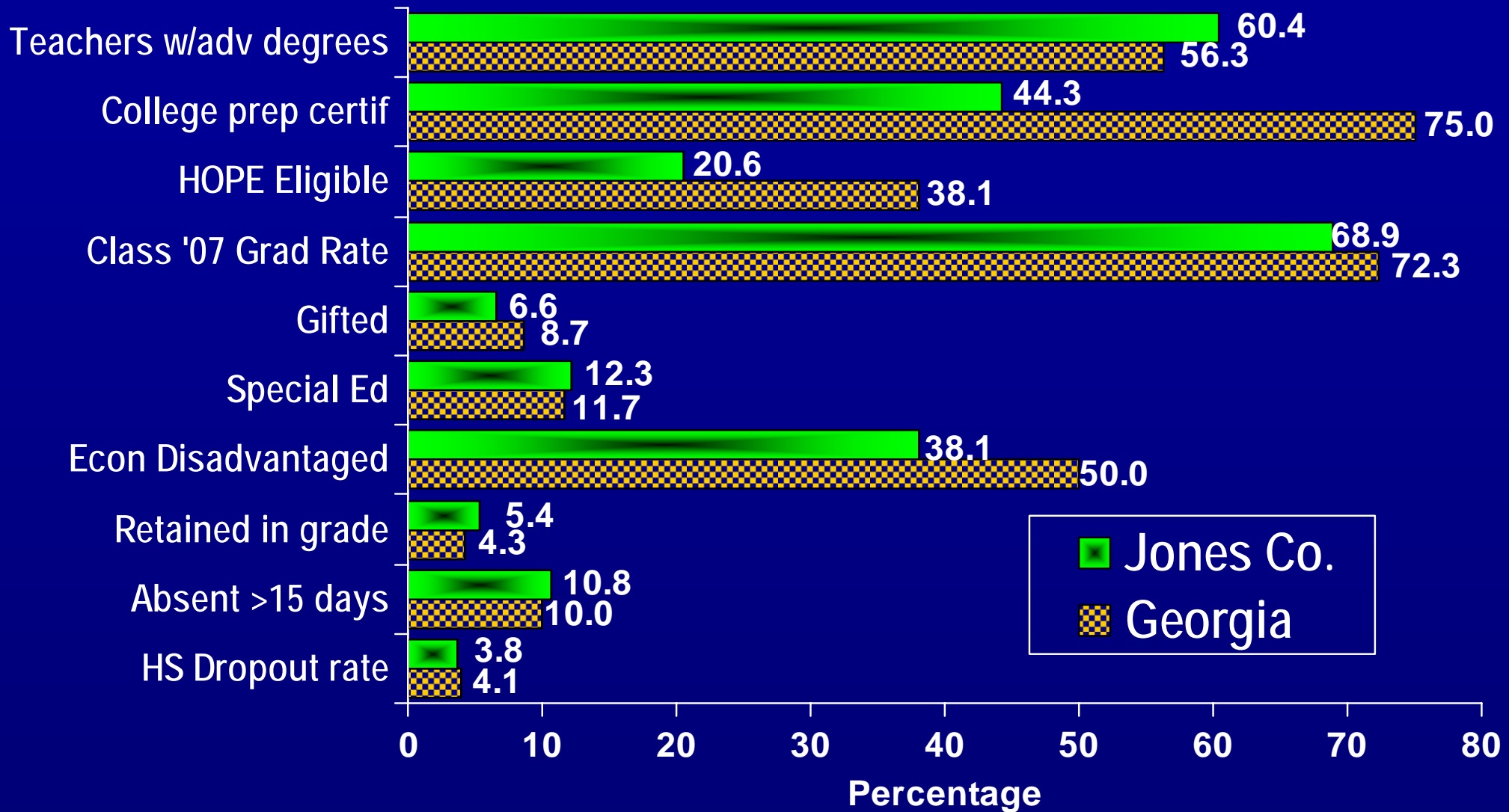

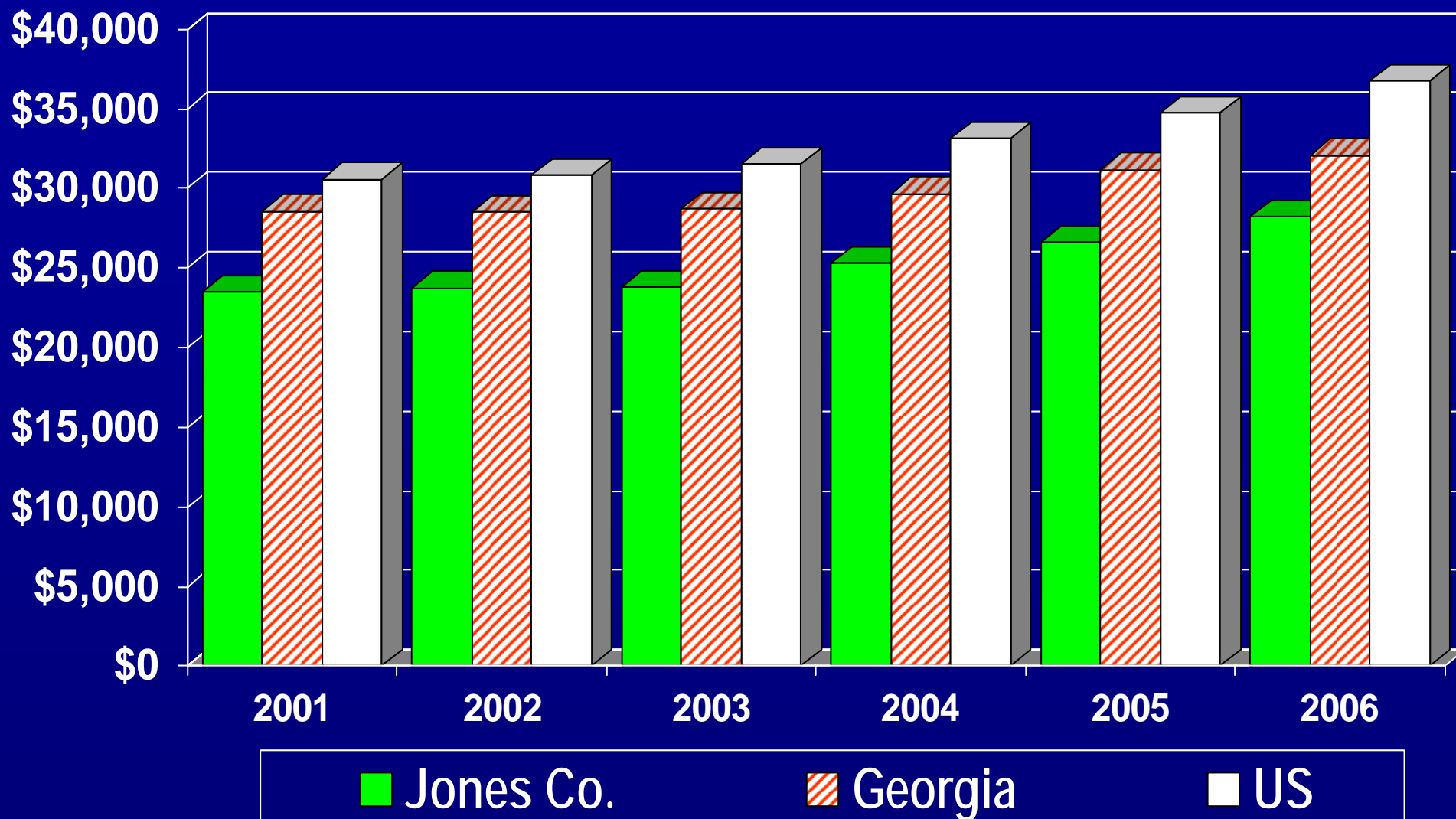

Per Capita Income: 2001-2006

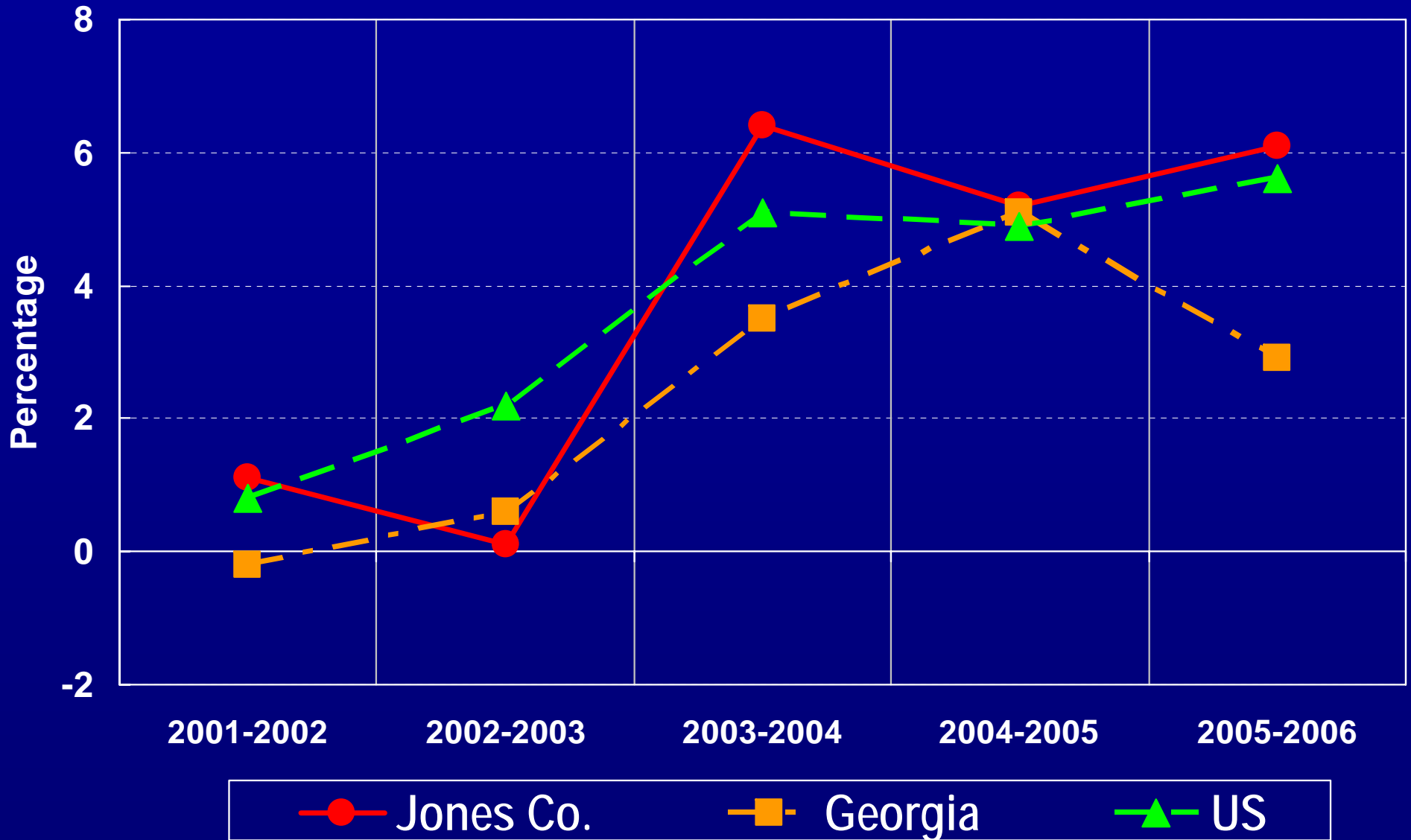

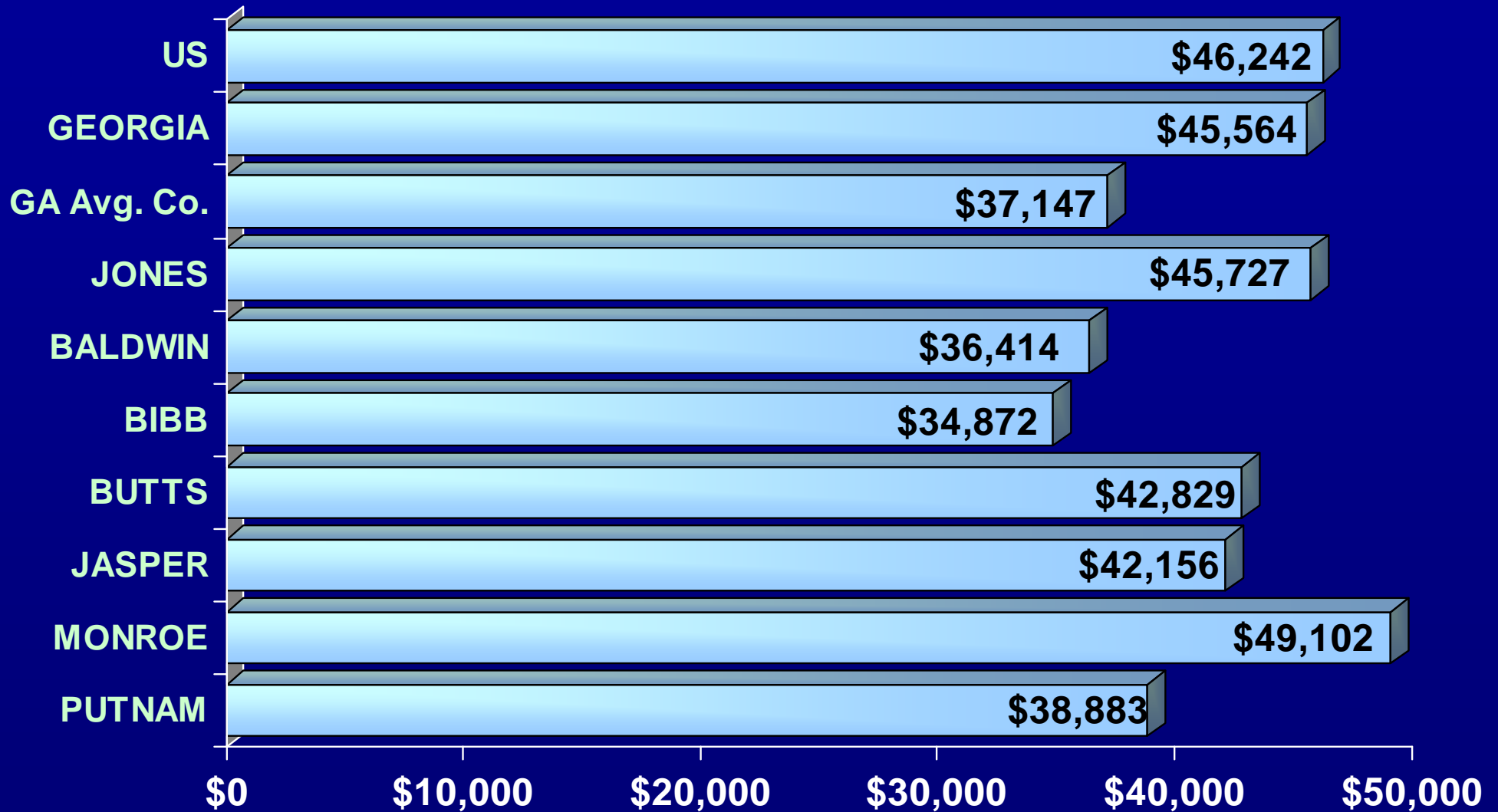

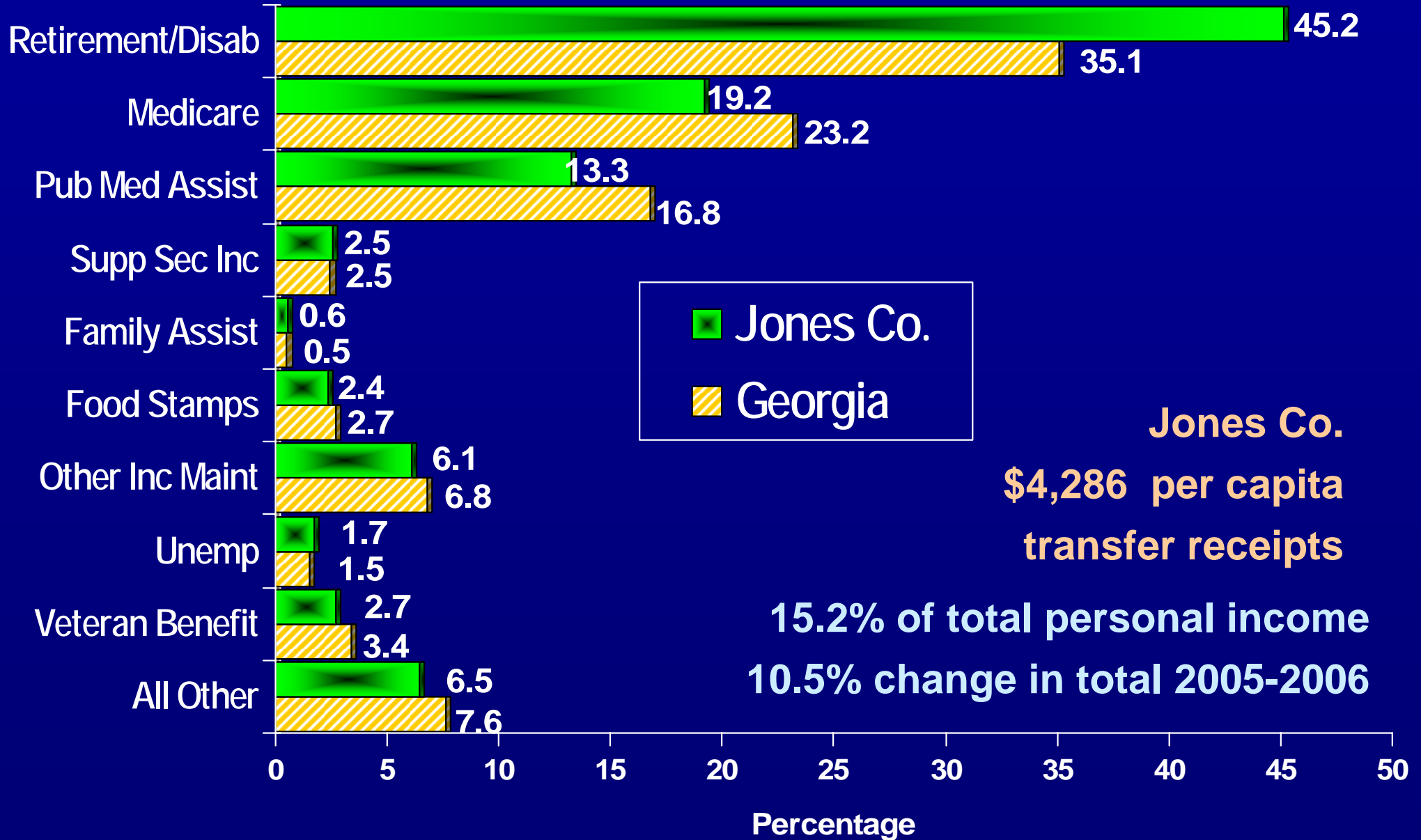
Median Household Income

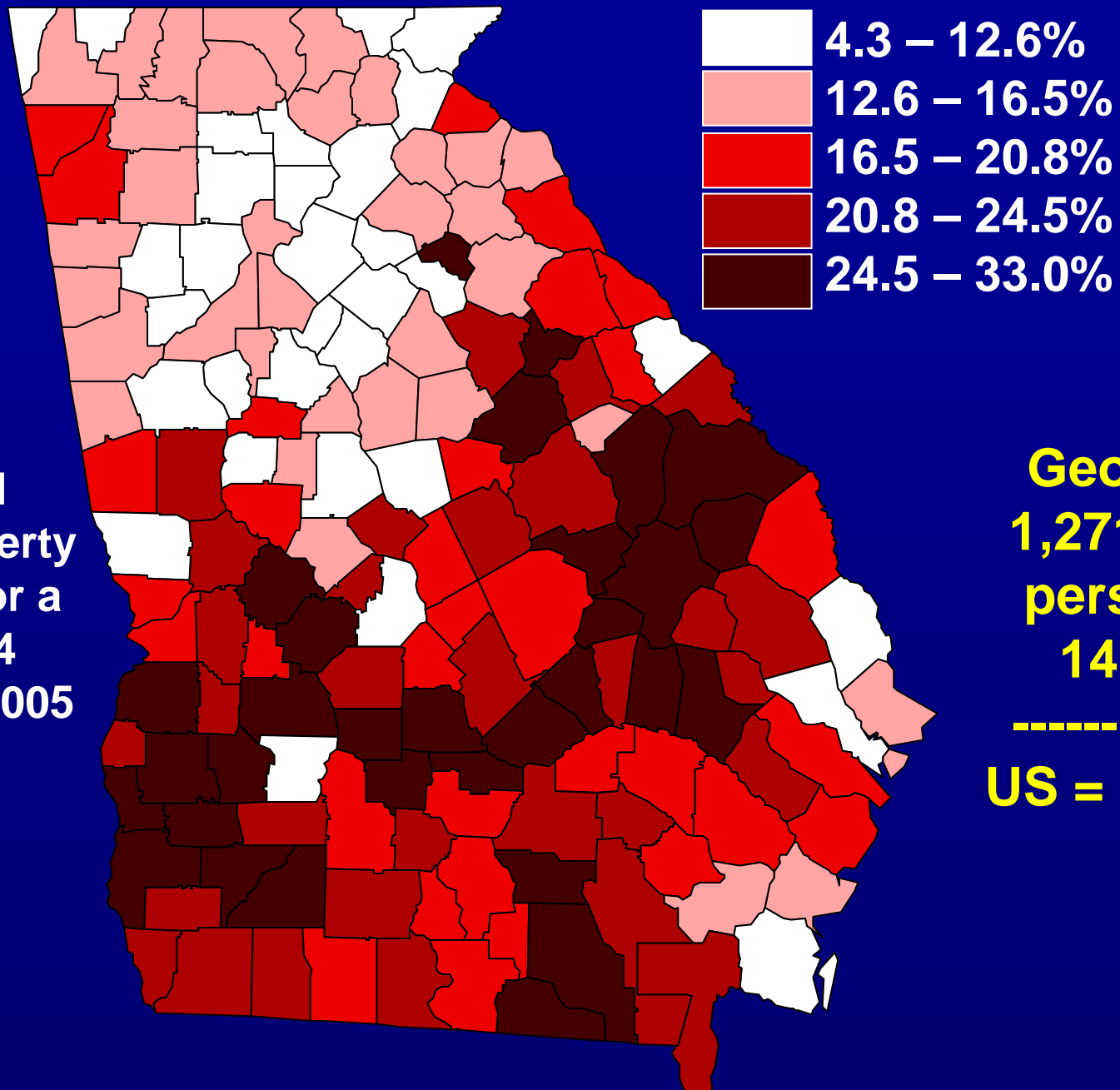

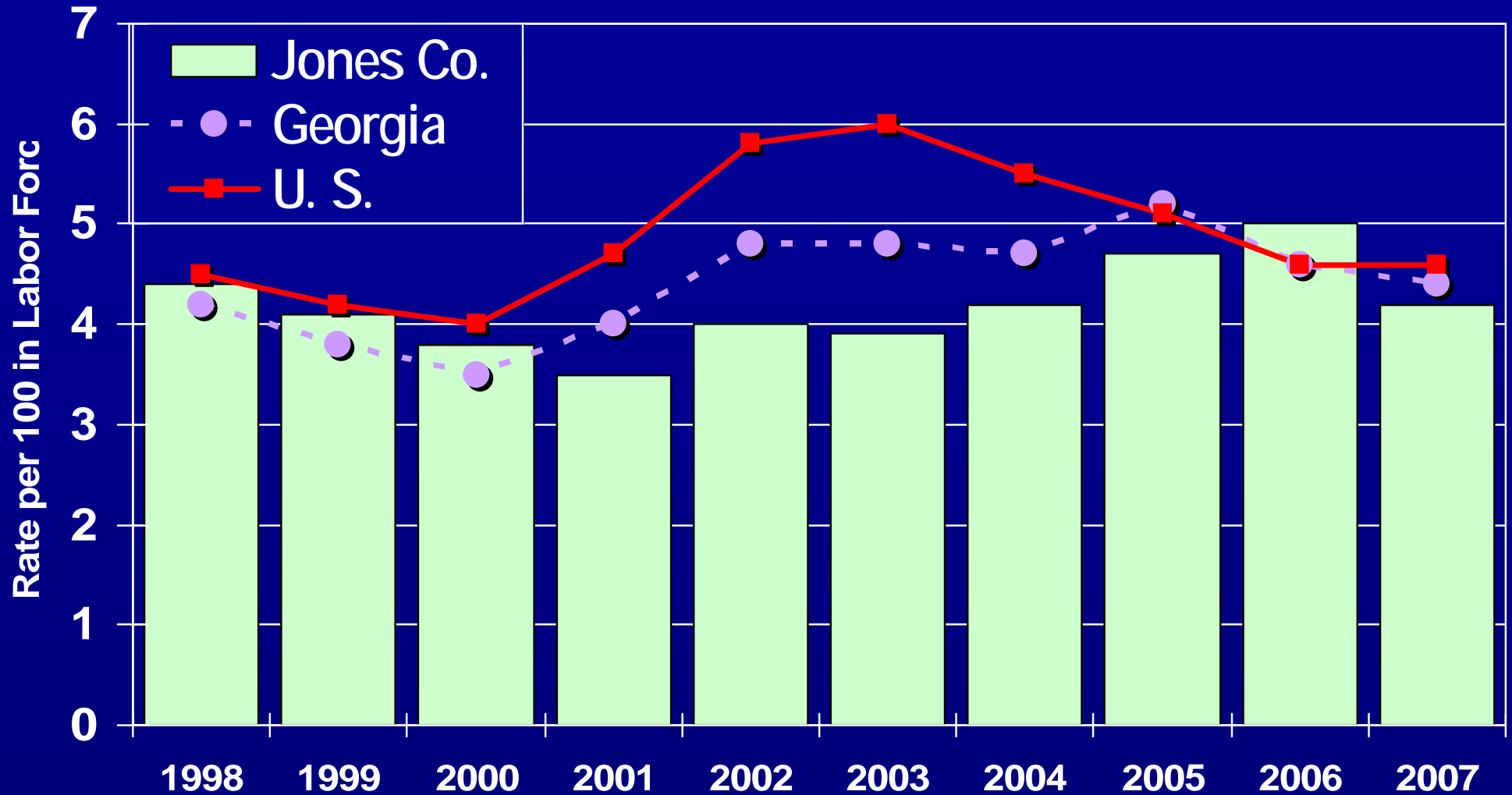

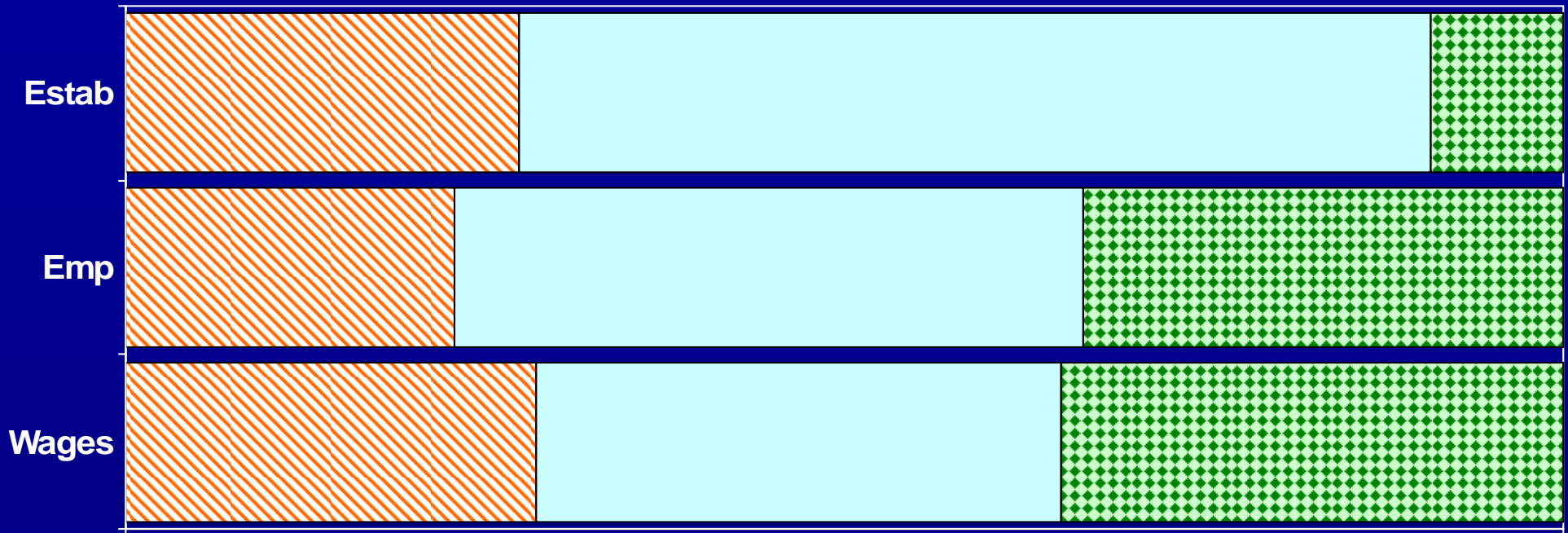

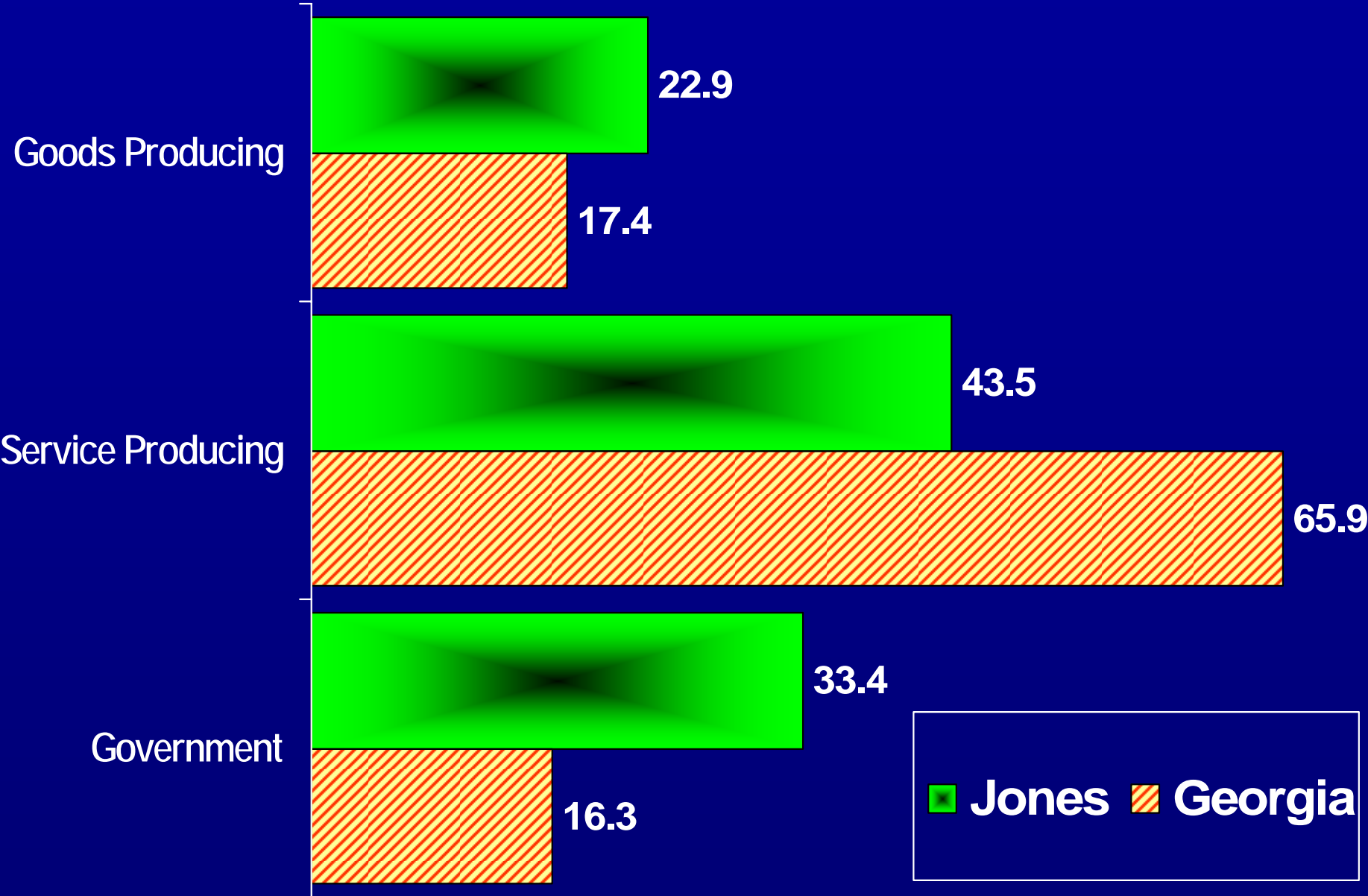

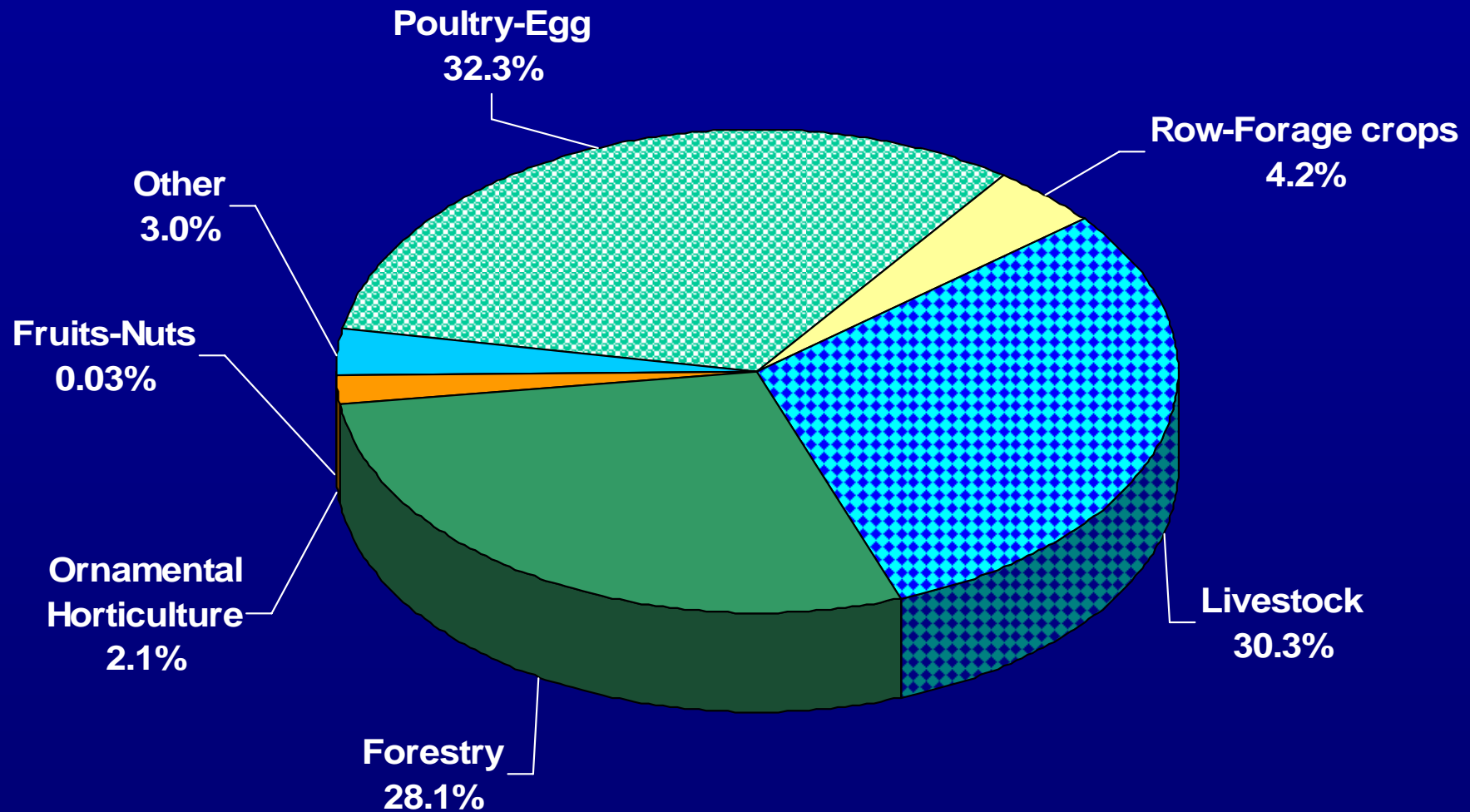
Employment Comparisons by Major Sectors: 2007

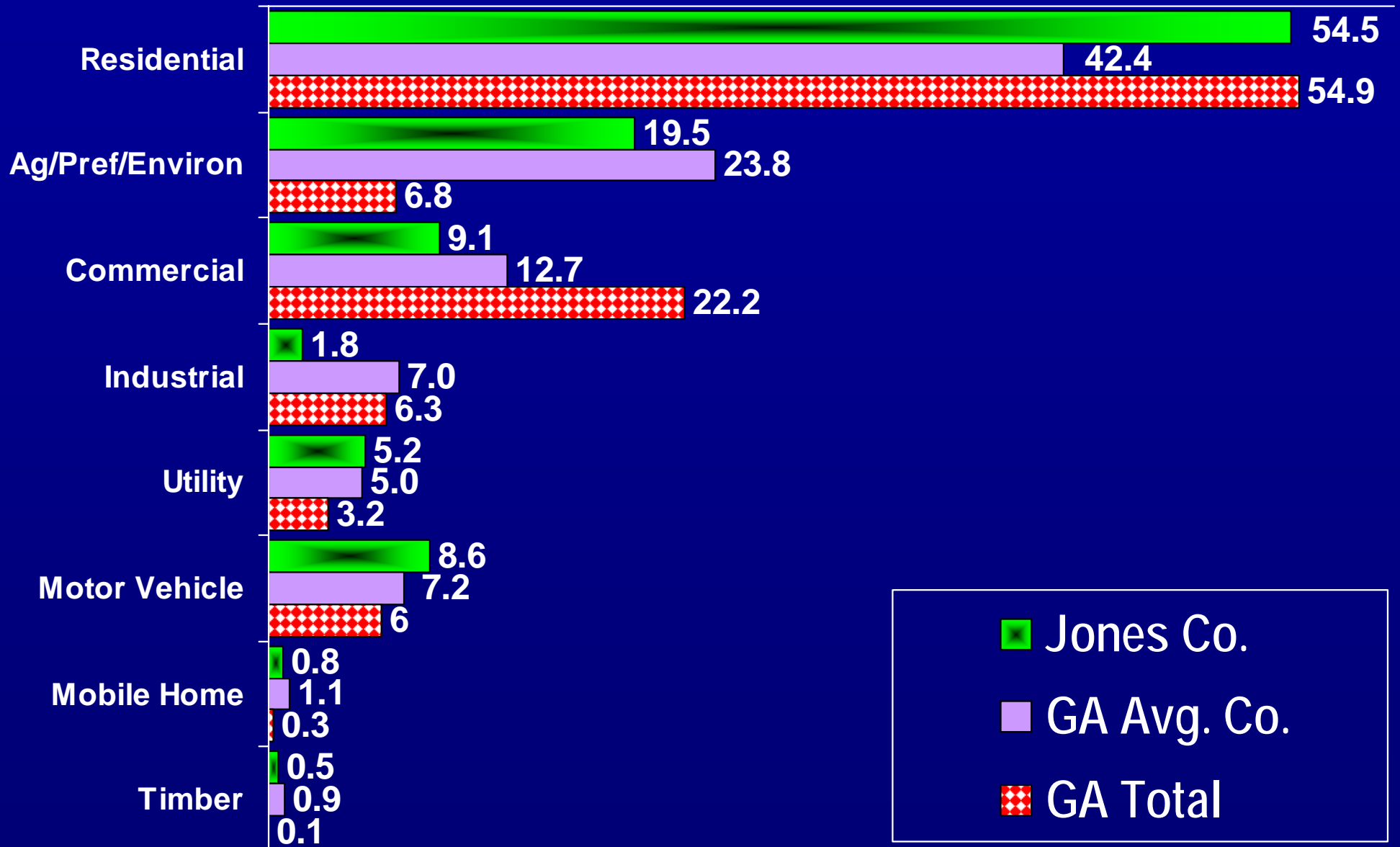
Farm Gate Value by Commodity Group: 2007

Retail Sales Analysis: 2007

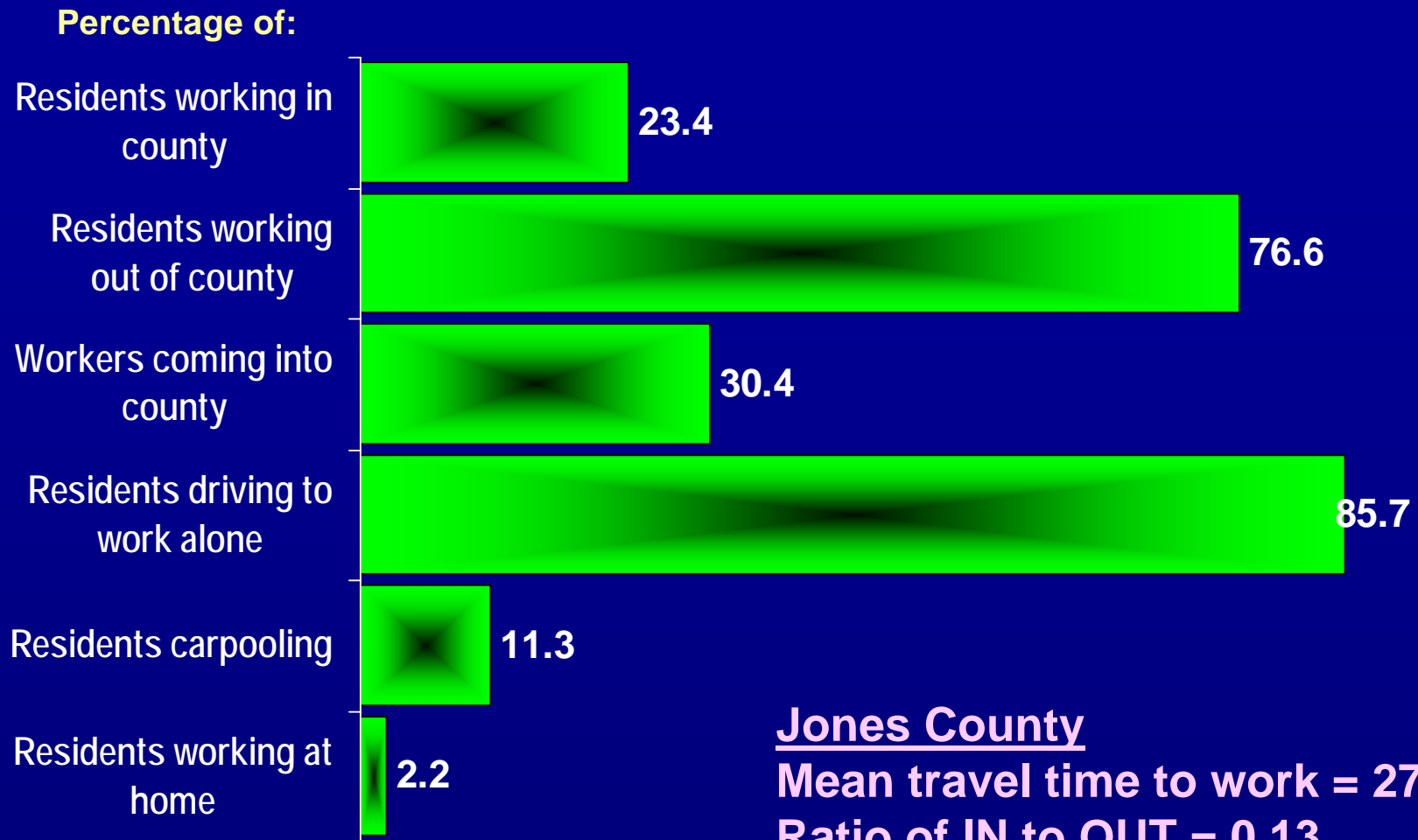
Jones Co. Total Retail Sales = \$61,299,000

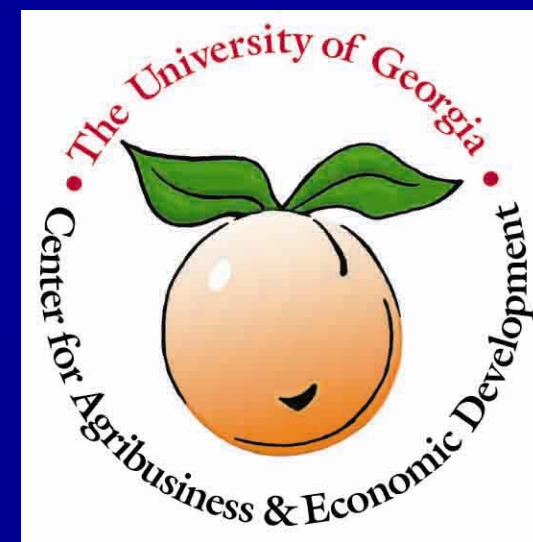
